Singapore, 7 September 2020 — Gluu's co-founder Lin Shu Fen has been named in a list of 100 women who have achieved outstanding accomplishments and made significant contributions in tech, in a first-ever Singapore 100 Women in Tech (SG100WIT) List.

More than 850 nominations were received from members of the public following an open call for nominations in March this year.
